

# PARENT WITH PURPOSE

# **Simple Ways to Approach Lent With Your Kids**

What if this Lenten season, we stopped to be present with our kids and with Jesus versus giving up a meager piece of chocolate? (No shame here; I gave up chocolate for years.) Even King David knew that God wasn't interested in what he gave up so much as what he was becoming. How do we get our kids on board with approaching Easter through the season of Lent with this attitude? This may mean giving up time-stealers—an activity, object, or event that robs you and your family time away from God.

I'm not offering specific things to do or even a list of actions (parents don't need more things to do) but ideas for families to reflect on this final week of Jesus's life on Earth and thinking more about who we are becoming.



Conversation starters around the table, in the car, and on the way are easy ways to engage kids and get them thinking. As you look around your world, invite your kids to see or hear what God might see or hear. Ask your child how Jesus would respond if He walked your neighborhood.

Create a safe place where kids can share what is troubling them. Give them space to ask for help or strength to quit sinning. Offer compassion and grace in your response and prayers. Plead with the Holy Spirit to convict your family of sin and to live and work through you.

Choose a Bible passage or story about the events leading up to Jesus's resurrection, starting with Palm Sunday. Find a time that works for your family, maybe breakfast or bedtime. As you read, stop to hear the clanking of coins as Jesus cleared the temple, smell the aroma of perfume poured over Jesus, or imagine the King of kings riding on the back of a donkey into Jerusalem. Ask questions: What do we learn about Jesus? What do we learn about those He interacted with in the passage? Invite questions from your kids, offer some of your own, and be okay with not always having the answer.

As you read the Bible, identify a verse that speaks to your family and print it on a mirror or the fridge. Let it soak into your very marrow. Chew on it for a week. What if your family practiced the command, believed the promise, or wrestled with a verse? Turn off the buzzing and beeping of screens for one day or one hour and allow scriptures to fill your minds. Take note of any differences.

Find moments within the rhythms of your family to spend these weeks leading up to Easter together with Him. This sojourn with Jesus may spark celebration and wonder at Jesus's resurrection.

# Labels, Lies, and the Truth

Their stories include abuse, addiction, lies and trauma. By the world's standards, their chances of finding freedom were slim to none. Yet, they sat on the Bridges set talking about how truth dispelled the lies, and love purchased their freedom.

## You'll never amount to anything

As I talked with Shakia, I was stunned to hear she was told "you'll never amount to anything" growing up. Listening to her story of being sexually abused as a child and by several family members made me angry. Yet here she was on the Bridges set sharing her dark moments of addiction and other tragedies – yet she was whole, at peace and free. Her freedom in Christ was a process, but she stayed the course at Blue Monarch, a non-profit that serves abused and addicted women and their children. Her time at Blue Monarch helped Shakia learn to recognize and reject the lies she was told growing up. She also had to forgive the very people that stole her innocence and attempted to diminish her value. Today Shakia is a Christian, a wonderful mom, and she has an amazing career as Officer of Development and Community Relations at Blue Monarch. Shakia is free.

# When she was just a teen her parents used drugs with her

Jessie Lane was the first Bridges guest to ever share that they were introduced to drugs by their parents. For Jessie Lane drugs, abuse, and darkness became her normal. She believed the generational lie that life would never change, and for years it didn't. Her story includes being dragged and forced into the woods by an ex-boyfriend. There the ex-boyfriend cut her with a knife and held her hostage for hours. At another point she lost custody of her daughter. This is a story that no one wants or deserves. But Jessie Lane's story takes a turn, and there she found a brand-new life. Today Jessie Lane is free. The drugs are gone, the generation lies exposed, and she was reunited with her daughter. Her freedom wrought by Christ, Jessie Lane's obedience, and the assistance of Blue Monarch, Monteagle TN.

#### Once an addict always an addict

Susan Binkley is the Founder and President of Blue Monarch, and she says it all started with a God-given dream. Susan does not have a personal addiction story, nor did she ever think about launching a non-profit where women and their children could live and recover. Yet God gave the dream and Susan obeyed. Susan now has a team of caring professionals who provide everything from parenting training to trauma therapy. As Susan and I talked on the Bridges set Susan said the phrase once an addict always an addict made her angry. I nodded in agreement because I have always believed that phrase was a horrible lie. When God gives you freedom you are free – you are a new creature in Christ. New life in Christ defies every single label. Every. Single. Time. Blue Monarch exists to show abused and addicted women and their children that freedom is possible.

# **Insurrection: The Supreme Court to the Rescue**

The final weeks of 2023 saw two firsts in U.S. history. On December 19, 2023, the Colorado Supreme Court ruled in a 4-3 split decision that former President Donald J. Trump was disqualified from holding the office of President, and that to place him on the presidential ballot would violate the insurrection clause of Section Three of the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. Nine days later, on December 28, 2023, the Maine Secretary of State Shenna Bellows followed suit and, citing the same legal grounds, removed Mr. Trump from the Maine presidential ballot as well.

The question is now before the Supreme Court, and a ruling is expected before March 5 Super Tuesday, the date sixteen states will hold their presidential primaries. The stakes in this case are enormous. If left to the courts of 50 states, litigation over a candidate's eligibility for President would result in conflicting rulings and delayed transition of power because of our nation's inability to meet certain constitutional deadlines for selecting its next president.

But the decision of the Colorado Supreme Court has consequences beyond just the next presidential election. If left undisturbed, it could affect the political stability of the nation, and expose the country to months, or perhaps years, of chaos.

For example, Congress has sole authority under the Constitution to remove a President from office for "Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors." The power to accuse a President of an impeachable offense resides solely with the House of Representatives, while the power to remove a President resides solely with the Senate. These bodies exercised this power twice against the sitting President Trump, and both times, he was acquitted. The Colorado Supreme Court, without any trial or hearing, simply determined that Congress got it wrong - both times.

The Colorado ruling also throws confusion into the executive branch's activities, too. If the Colorado decision is correct, some have argued that the former President would be immediately disqualified at the moment he purportedly engaged in insurrection on January 6, 2021. Under this view, the actions that President Trump took between January 7 and January 20, including the bills he signed into law, would not be constitutionally valid. Thanks to Colorado, then, some would say that America was without a President for a full two weeks.

The Fourteenth Amendment provides that "no person shall ... hold any office ... who, having previously taken an oath ... as an officer of the United States ... to support the Constitution of the United States, shall have engaged in insurrection or rebellion against the same." But just what type of conduct constitutes insurrection? At the time this language was adopted, the U.S. had just concluded a long and bloody civil war. Those who had taken up arms to defend the Confederacy were the ones targeted by this new amendment. Yet, several of those Confederate officers were later allowed to serve in Congress. Is a mere assemblage of people shouting enough to constitute an insurrection? If two people link arms across a sidewalk to block a poll worker from entering a ballot-counting site, does that hinder the transfer of power enough to constitute an outright insurrection? Taking the actions committed on January 6 at their worst, was there ever an actual effort to overthrow the government? The Supreme Court has these and several other perplexing questions before it in this case.

# **Understanding Hair Loss: Unveiling the Science Behind It**

What causes hair loss? Unfortunately, the answer to that question is complicated. There are a number of possible causes, and it can take some detective work to determine the source in your particular case. While there are about 18 documented causes, there are five that are most common. Chances are, your hair loss falls into one of these categories. At the very least, these are where you should start in determining why your hair is thinning:

- **1. Genetics.** Just like male pattern baldness, genetics can be the cause of hair loss in women as well. It usually involves thinning of the front hairline, temples, or all the way to the crown of the head. This cause needs to be ruled out through a DNA test or TrichoTest™.
- **2. Autoimmune Disorders.** In an autoimmune disorder, the body mistakenly identifies your own hair follicle cells as foreign agents and attacks them in a misguided effort to protect you. In this case, the hair loss may appear across the scalp, as well as the eyebrows, eyelashes, and beard. If you start to see balding areas, a significant amount of hair loss in the shower, or thinning of the edges of your eyebrows, an autoimmune disease may be the culprit.

There are a number of autoimmune disorders, but Hashimoto's thyroiditis is one of the most common, as thyroid issues are frequently the reason for hair loss. The best way to determine if this is the case is to be tested for autoimmune antibodies and thyroid markers. Unfortunately, most doctors don't test for all thyroid markers, so you need to specifically request a full set of these blood tests. If an autoimmune disorder is determined to be the

cause of your hair loss, treatment may include dietary and gut health recommendations, nutritional supplements, and/or prescription medications.

- **3. Scalp Conditions.** Diseases like eczema and psoriasis can lead to hair loss. If you have noticed your hair thinning, examine your scalp carefully, and visit a dermatologist for a proper diagnosis. Bear in mind, too, that psoriasis is an autoimmune disorder, and people who have one of these disorders often eventually develop more of them, especially if they are left untreated. Therefore, it's important to treat scalp conditions early.
- **4. Underlying Health Conditions.** To determine if an underlying condition is the cause of your hair loss, you will need to get a full set of laboratory tests. Most of us neglect these to our detriment. We need to stay on top of these numbers to determine if we have any vitamin or mineral deficiencies. As I mentioned in number 2, this includes a full workup of thyroid markers.

Other deficiencies to specifically note include iron, ferritin, and vitamin D. All of these particularly play a critical role in hair growth and the health of your hair follicles. Note that your levels of these nutrients should be in the optimal range or at least in the high normal range. If they're in the low or mid-normal range, you may not have enough of these nutrients to prevent your hair loss. If your vitamin D level is especially low, you may need an IV infusion or a prescription-strength supplement for a few weeks before starting a maintenance dose.

Please don't supplement these on your own, however. You should have your levels tested and



be directed by a medical practitioner to make sure you take the proper dosage. It's also important to check your nutrient levels regularly, preferably on an annual basis.

**5. Traction Alopecia.** This condition results from (1) frequent twirling, picking, and pulling of the hair, eyebrows, and/or eyelashes. Frequent repetitive behaviors can also be linked to this form of alopecia; or (2) tension and strain on the hair strands and follicles from tight ponytails, braids, or weaves. Over time, the hair follicle can lose enough strength that it actually dies. Therefore, it's important to recognize the problem early before it's too late.

Hair loss can often be treated and improved, but the cause must be pinpointed first. If you are losing hair, pay close attention to your symptoms, and get the medical help you need to determine the source and receive proper treatment.


After that 10 year sentence, he knew he had to change the path of his life. "I went to the Carrier Center and they approved me to go to truck driving

# A Time to Weep, Time to Laugh

At the '24 Golden Globes, the comedian Jim Gaffigan made a joke heard 'round the online world. "I can't believe I'm in the entertainment industry. It's so unlikely," he began in his usual, sarcastic, and slightly bewildered way, "I'm just a guy from a small town in Indiana. I'm not a pedophile."

The infamous Epstein client list was released 5 days earlier. In a room filled with A-list celebrities, Gaffigan's joke earned a mid-level laugh.

What world do we live in where the people lauded as the most beautiful, most talented, or the funniest, can joke like this and find it funny? And when a film like "The Sound of Freedom" (a "based on a true story" movie about human trafficking) has breakout success, those same people slap inflammatory titles on it. Or say nothing at all.

Victims of sexual abuse and human trafficking are not entertainment fodder for Hollywood. Men and women, and boys and girls of all ages can be and are being affected.

But what exactly is human trafficking? It is not synonymous with sex trafficking, but they often happen together. Sex trafficking is forcing or coercing someone to participate in sex acts for money. Human trafficking is forcing or coercing someone into debt bondage, peonage, slavery, or involuntary servitude.

This second crime is more prominent in poorer countries where families often pull their children out of school to help the family earn enough money to survive. Children are sold with the belief they will be able to go home. Instead, they are forced to work 16 hours a day in factories and on farms you wouldn't want to step foot in.

Some of the products these children make are probably in your home right now. Have a Hershey, Mars, or Nestle product? Many Western African farms have young children wielding machetes to extract cocoa beans from their pods. And you know that awesome new top you got online for

super cheap? Companies who can sell things at those prices aren't paying fair wages somewhere in their production line. Children are cheap, submissive laborers.

Help us fight human trafficking. Spread the word.

But this can change, and you can be part of it. More organizations now exist to give you opportunities to help fight these atrocities. Right here in Nashville, Tennessee, Rescue 1 Global is doing exactly that.

Founded in 2011 by missionaries Daniel and Lacy Henson Tolar, Rescue 1 Global is an independent, full-scale prevention, rescue, and restoration mission to fight human-trafficking locally and around the world. It was during a 2011 mission trip to Thailand, a hotspot for human trafficking, that the Tolars' eyes were opened.

And as we all know, once God shows you something, you can't look away. So the Tolars did as Jesus commanded, they became His hands and feet. They found Thai Christians whose hearts God had also softened, and they got to work. Then God showed up again. Others were moved by their work, and what started in Thailand eventually grew into the Philippines, Loas, and India.

When the Tolars came back to Nashville, they were ready to rest, but their eyes couldn't be shut. As they soon discovered, human trafficking wasn't a third-world problem, it was an everywhere problem, even in the buckle of the Bible belt. So, once again, the Tolars rolled up their sleeves and got to work.

Over the last 12 years, Rescue 1 has saved 847 people from this darkness. That's easy to read and gloss over. "Glory to God!", "Yes!", "Hallelujah!", and "Amen," we all say. We should rejoice, but we should also realize this is not a somewhere else problem. Human trafficking is happening everywhere, and the problem is growing.

But such a sinful and horrible thing could never happen where you live, surely? Sadly, yes. Jonathan Williams is Rescue 1's current Board Chair and an ardent volunteer. He

connected with Daniel and Lacy in 2020. During the pandemic, the Nashville mayor's office got in touch with Rescue 1 to ask for help. They had moved many of the homeless community into a local motel to curb COVID cases. What they soon discovered was rampant prostitution, and they didn't know what to do. Rescue 1 asked Jonathan's church for help and he never looked back. But that's Nashville. It's urban. That would never happen in the suburbs.

Over the phone, Jonathan told me of a girl in the Brentwood public school system whose uncle would pick her up at 1 AM, sell her for a few hours, then take her home. For years, her parents were clueless until a DCS worker reached out to Rescue 1 for help. The girl's parents didn't believe them, so Rescue 1 gathered evidence. When the uncle found out, he fled to his home country and the girl's trafficking stopped. When the uncle flew into Atlanta 2 years later, he was promptly arrested. Thank God.

More recently, Jonathan was having breakfast at First Watch in Cool Springs. He saw a teenage girl with an older woman outside near a car and felt the Holy Spirit's prompting. He went outside and saw the girl sell herself to the man in the car.

Further south in Spring Hill, Jonathan knew a local girl who, several years after her high school graduation, ended up with a drug addiction and a 6-figure debt to her dealer. About this, Jonathan said, "The dealer let her try to work off the debt. Surprisingly, within 3-4 years, she did. But there were days [when we were doing community outreach] when I saw her get into 3-4 cars in an hour." The sad part? Jonathan knew her parents, knew they would

take her back in a heartbeat, but she wouldn't accept Rescue 1's help. Victims often see themselves as too broken to be redeemed. "But we're out there to love them and share the gospel. We can't save them, only the Holy Spirit can," he added.

But drugs aren't the only gateway to being trafficked or abused. "Parents think their kids are safe because they lock their phones. They're not," Jonathan adds. Because he knows of a girl whose phone was locked down, but someone hacked in and started sending her friendly messages. Eventually, the hacker asked for photos. Though nothing explicit was shared, the only reason it stopped was because the girl's father heard her phone go off in the middle of the night and saw the messages.

Jonathan has seen trafficking victims throughout Nashville and even into Columbia, but sex trafficking has happened in all 95 Tennessee counties. In 2023, according to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation's report, there were over 600 reported cases of minor (under 18) sex trafficking in Tennessee. That was 10 times the amount from 2017, and the vast majority are reported by social services workers. In the same report, the TBI acknowledged they had received tips for minor sex trafficking for children as young as 5 months. The average age for sex trafficking victims in Tennessee is 13-17, in line with the national average.

But these trends don't have to get worse. We can pray, as we all should, but we can also help. You don't have to join law enforcement and wear a badge every day, but you can help prevent, help rescue, or help restore.

Rescue 1 offers all three services to victims of human trafficking, and anyone can get involved. Really. The first step to stopping this crisis is prevention. Outreach teams, like the one Jonathan serves on, get to know traffickers and their victims through repeated contact. When asked, Jonathan insists it is much safer than we might believe. Groups go out in 3-4, usually with armed protection. But the victims know the faces of the outreach teams. They look forward to seeing them because they offer homecooked meals and hygiene products.

"But," he adds, "we would love to have more women on the outreach teams. Women get a completely different response than men do. They're treated more warmly and people will tell them things they won't tell men, because we look like the people they're being trafficked to."

Surveillance teams can liaise with law enforcement by providing security, being part of the outreach teams, finding "business" locations, or gathering information.

Mobile Ops teams get the victims out or help relocate them. Rescue is most often needed overseas, and can be asked for by law enforcement, district attorneys, medical and social workers, or even the victims. "We don't kick down that many doors though. So many guys want to kick down doors, but that's about 1% of the time," Jonathan quips. "It's not Jim Caviezel running through the jungle."

The third step is restoration. Arguably, the most important, but the most difficult stage to get victims to. "It's incredibly frustrating, but so often we talk to people who promise to meet us next week [to get on the bus to rehab] because they want to go get high one more time. When they do that, I know they won't show up," Jonathan notes. Don't they want to get away from that life? For too many, getting high and being sold is all they know. They don't have Christmas celebrations or small groups. Victims of sex trafficking tend to see themselves as worthless. When your body is sold for pleasure,

why would you believe anyone cares about the soul inside it?

But for those who accept Rescue 1's help and are moved to rehab or a safe house, the biggest need is for people to love on these women and/or are willing to host a Bible study. You don't have to be Franklin Graham or Lisa Turkeurst, just willing to answer God's call.

Even if your schedule is full, consider donating old clothing, canned food, or feminine hygiene products. (Especially that last item.) If you know of a group willing to cook, donating homecooked meals is the key to gaining these victims' trust.

But keep this in mind, according to Jonathan: "A lot of places donate pasta, but these people want real, homecooked food. Who doesn't? When we show up with casseroles or burgers with mashed potatoes, they line up to talk to us."

One of Rescue 1's board members, so Jonathan tells me, has a large grill and will spend a few hours grilling over 100 burgers for the outreach teams to hand out. If you manage to burn even rice, there's also a need for people to help box up food for the outreach teams. If your time is slim, but your wallet is blessed, money is the easiest way to sustain Rescue 1. You can buy Rescue 1 merchandise, everything from art to mugs to candles to hats. You can join the prayer team and fight on the spiritual front as well.

But whatever you do, don't look away. Human trafficking is only getting worse. Right now, as many as 50 million people are enslaved globally. This industry is estimated to bring in \$150 billion dollars a year, right behind the drug trade. And its biggest consumer? The United States.

Hollywood thinks it can afford to laugh this off because we continue laughing, continue watching, continue singing along. Laughing isn't bad, and neither is a good show, but if you want to support Rescue 1 and have a good time, join their "Rise to Freedom: Music & Comedy Show" on February 29th, 2024, at Thompson Station Church in Thompson Station, Tenn. 



# Intentional Actions Lead to Unintentional Consequences

From the moment we wake up, we begin to make choices. Some of these choices are intentional, in other words, well thought-out; the rest will be unintentional, what I call, "going through the motions". Both can be positive or negative, based on truths, falsehoods, and misconceptions. The one thing that makes humanity a complicated species is that we can make decisions that go

# **How to Clean an Air Fryer**

Air fryers are the latest kitchen craze, especially for fans of all things fried. These new kitchen must-haves offer a healthier take on some of your favorite fried foods with minimal grease and very little mess. It's made preparing dinner more convenient than ever, but it does take some cleaning to keep it fired up for next time. We've put together a few air fryer cleaning tips to make the job easier!

# How Often Should You Clean an Air Fryer?

Using your air fryer is so quick and easy, you might think that the minimal mess makes it something you don't have to clean often. But do you have to clean an air fryer after every

use? We'd recommend cleaning at least the removable parts every time you fire it up. This can help keep small bits of food out of places they shouldn't be and keeps your food tasting great meal after meal. A dirty air fryer has a few drawbacks:

- Takes longer to heat up
- Uses more energy
- Burned-on food will be even harder to clean the longer it stays on the air fryer
- Food residue from a previous meal can alter the taste of what you're cooking

You should clean your air fryer's basket, tray, and pan after each use.

#### **Get Your Cleaning Supplies**

Clean your air fryer without chemicals, if possible. Cleaning your air fryer regularly will reduce the chance of needing harsher chemicals to get it looking new again. If you do need a cleaning solution, make sure you read the label of the cleaning chemical to ensure it is safe to use on food preparation devices or surfaces.

For a deep clean, you'll need:

- Baking soda
- Dish soap
- A soft-bristle brush
- A sponge or microfiber cloth


# **Be Cool (Or At Least Room Temperature)**

Before attempting to clean your air fryer, make sure it has completely cooled down after use. It can take as long as 30 minutes for your air fryer to get to room temperature, so consider doing the other dishes first (or, hey, maybe just relax for a bit!).

# Clean the Air Fryer Basket, Tray, and Pan

Either in the sink or a plastic tub, wash all the air fryer's removable parts in warm, soapy water. It can be helpful to let them soak for 15 minutes or so to help break up burned-on grease or food. Use your soft-bristle brush to tackle hard-to-reach nooks and crannies. Making a paste out of your baking soda and water is also a good way to remove any food residue. Always make sure you've rinsed the components well to remove any soap particles. Depending





parts might even be dishwasher safe. If you use your air fryer regularly, make sure those make it on a rack!

# Wipe Down the Inside of the Air Fryer

With a damp microfiber cloth or sponge and a small amount of dish soap, wipe down the interior of the air fryer. Use another damp cloth without soap to wipe the inside of the fryer dry. This is a good chance to wipe down any other components of the air fryer, including the screen that is built into some models.

# **Check the Air Fryer Heating Element**

It's okay to use a damp cloth on the heating element, but skip the soap. You'll need to flip the unit upside down and scrub gently to remove any scorched food particles.

Wipe The Exterior of the Air Fryer

Remove the grease drip pan and empty it after each use and rinse it in the sink. Use a damp, soapy cloth and remove any stuck-on food. Just like the inside of the air fryer, you'll also want to use another rag to wipe away any remaining soap; it's often helpful to finish with a paper towel to make it shine! Leave the air fryer disassembled to air dry for 30-60 minutes. As you put it back together, inspect it to ensure it is completely dry to avoid any short circuits or other electrical issues.



# **Perfected, Not Perfect**

We are trained in our culture to be afraid of failure. We are used to watching movies and reading stories that do not allow for failure. We are taught that it makes us vulnerable and weak. But, when we go to, and through, failure is when we really get better. We must understand the concept of failure and its role in perfecting us in our health and training.



What does it really mean to be perfected? It isn't being perfect. Being perfected means that we "count it all joy when we fall into various trials" and know that we can let failure and trials "perfect us" so that we are available and able to do everything that God has called us to. Failure is a part of going from Glory to Glory. It is a part of the process. Health is a process. It is God's intention for us to get better and better as we become more and more like Him; in health and in every aspect of life.

The concept I want us to understand as it relates to failure is two-fold. Firstly, we must not be afraid of setting goals that we may fail at. If we set goals that we are always hitting in our training, then we are not achieving our full potential. Think about it, if we set a

goal to lose 1 pound a week and hit that goal then we will settle for those results. But if we set a goal that is bigger like losing 5 pounds per week but we only lose 3 pounds, then isn't that much better? By setting bigger goals we push ourselves to achieve greater results, even if we experience "failure" as a result.

Secondly, we must go through failure if we want to get better. If we just go to failure we will never get better because failure is our current limit of ability. Here, I am talking about our ability to engage our muscles in movement, until after they fail – this

means we have worn down every available muscle fiber, pushing our bodies to rebuild them, stronger. So, if we just toe the line of failure then we will never push the line any further and get better. We stay at our current level. This is how people fall into the infamous "plateau" that we try so hard to avoid. We can get better and better by using this concept.

Let's be honest, it doesn't feel good to fail. It is a vulnerable place to be in. But failure is an essential part of the process that all of us walk through to get better and better. I would encourage you to set goals and hold you accountable. We can't do this alone. We need to have each other's back as we partner in health. Are you willing to go to and through failure as you go from Glory to Glory?

# **Love After Divorce: Focus On Supporting The Kids**

With Valentine's Day approaching, we often focus on romantic love between adults or married couples who express their ongoing commitment to one another. However, there are other "dynamics" to celebrate when it comes to loving relationships between people. Today I am thinking of the love between a child and their parent.



It is very important for children to love and enjoy their parents, even if (especially when) there has been a divorce. There is a biological and emotional connection between mothers and children as well as fathers and children and BOTH are important to help children have a full life. We often show sympathy for a child if they lose a parent to death; we quickly assess what is missing and how much that will be a concern for the child. What we don't always recognize is when a child loses contact with a parent because of divorce or an angry parent who alienates the child from their "other parent" to try and eliminate or destroy the relationship. Sadly, this happens everyday in so many heartbreaking ways.

Adults get divorced for many reasons and sometimes the pain and hurt lingers for years, making it difficult for the adults to get along; however, for all that goes poorly between the parents, kids desire to enjoy their parents and continue to love them both. The research\* shows us that there are five "coparent categories" that exist after divorce, and each has a unique and direct impact on the shared children.

**Perfect Pals:** These divorced coparents continue to communicate and get along well, even though divorced. (The kids are often confused on why their parents got divorced since they are all together so often.)

**Cooperative Colleagues:** These divorced coparents are like business partners in that they are consistent with their communication, and it is only about the children. Their interactions are mostly respectful and mature. (These kids experience emotional freedom to love each parent and enjoy their two families.)


**Angry Associates:** These parents argue about everything, all the time. They argue about backpacks, water bottles, lunch boxes and often are outwardly argumentative at school, ballgames and the childrens' events. (Kids with these type coparents live in high stress and experience high anxiety due to their parents active anger.) **Fiery Foes:** These parents don't communicate well and often use the children as their "messenger" instead of communicating with each other directly. (These kids end up "parentified" and live with emotional PTSD because of the pressure they experience between their mom and dad.)

**Dissolved Duos:** This category is known for when there is only one parent and the other parent has moved away, walked away or is pushed out of the child's life. (The child lives with a hole in their soul the size of the missing parent.)

The healthiest goal for kids is to have "Cooperative Colleagues" who work together for the child's best interest and allow the kids to grow up loving everyone in their two-part family. This Valentine's Day, find a single parent who is recently divorced and share this info with them so they can have the critical insight of what is best for their kids!

# **Justice is Coming for Jeffrey Epstein's Victims**

For years, we have known about financier Jeffrey Epstein's alleged sex trafficking ring. We know the abuse spanned decades and harmed untold numbers of vulnerable, young girls. And we know a large network of high-profile, high-dollar predators participated in this horrific abuse.

But to date, only one person has ever faced justice for these crimes: Ghislaine Maxwell, Epstein's longtime associate who is serving a 20-year sentence for recruiting and grooming many of the victims. With the recent release of documents by a federal judge exposing part of Epstein's potential client list, however, we are finally moving in the

right direction to help bring accountability to the predators who participated in this sexual exploitation and justice to their victims.

The court order unsealed the names of more than 170 associates named in a lawsuit against Maxwell by one of Epstein's alleged victims. While many of the people named in the documents are not accused of any crimes, many others are accused of wrongdoing or are potential witnesses of Epstein's trafficking ring. The documents also revealed details about Epstein's alleged abuse, including that he and his associates trafficked girls as young as 12 years old and would target them at nightclubs.

The release of this information is just the first step to uncovering the truth; the latest documents come from just one case involving one victim. There are countless others who were targeted, trafficked, and abused.

That's why I have repeatedly requested a subpoena for the complete, unreducted Epstein flight logs and Ghislaine Maxwell's unreducted "little black book" of contacts and addresses, along with all documents and records from the FBI regarding Epstein and Maxwell. The American people have the right to know who flew on Epstein's plane, who witnessed these crimes, and who potentially participated in his international sex trafficking ring.

I'm grateful that all Republicans on the Senate Judiciary Committee are united in supporting my efforts to subpoena these documents. And while Judiciary Chairman Dick Durbin (D-Ill.) previously stonewalled my requests, I am encouraged that he has seemingly had a change of heart and expressed a willingness to work on a bipartisan basis to obtain records relevant to the Epstein case. In the weeks ahead, I will be urging a vote on my subpoena whenever possible at Judiciary Committee meetings until the innocent victims receive the justice they deserve.

Still, we know this issue goes far beyond Epstein and his associates. In America, a child is bought or sold for sexual exploitation on average every two minutes. Between 2018 and 2023, cartel revenues for human smuggling soared from \$500 million to \$13 billion. And globally, the Department of Homeland Security estimates that human traffickers make a staggering \$150 billion in profits each year.



While much of this trafficking occurs at our Southern border, we know this issue impacts every single community in our country. Across Tennessee, I have heard from law enforcement officers, healthcare personnel, and school officials about the increasing prevalence of sex trafficking in our state. In fact, according to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, reports of sex trafficking of minors jumped from 66 in 2016 to more than 600 in 2021—a nearly ten-fold increase. Through November of last year, there were nearly 700 reports of sex trafficking, spanning every single region in the state.

One thing should be clear: This isn't a celebrity issue. This is about modern day

slavery. And shedding light on these crimes—including by Epstein and his associates—can help bring an end to this widespread, pervasive abuse.

Still, there is so much more we can do to provide law enforcement with the tools they need to catch these predators.

The bipartisan "SAVE Girls" Act, which I introduced last year with Senator Klobuchar (D-Minn.), would provide states, local governments, and non-profits with vital resources they need to train personnel, conduct rescues, and help save trafficking victims.

The SALONS Stories Act, which I introduced with Senator Duckworth (D-Ill.), would incentivize training for cosmetologists and beauticians so that they can spot signs of sexual abuse among their clients and get them the help they need. This initiative replicates a program in Tennessee, Shear Haven, that has helped countless girls and women.

And the REPORT Act, which I led with Senator Ossoff (D-Ga.) and was unanimously passed by the U.S. Senate last month, would equip the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children and law enforcement with essential resources to crack down on child trafficking and online child sex abuse material.

I am pleased these crucial pieces of legislation are moving forward, and I am hopeful that with greater transparency—especially regarding the Epstein case—we can start to break apart these sex trafficking rings and ensure that these predators are put in jail where they belong.

#### ASK...


